Explanation of Levies

Special Levy P&C

This levy enables the P&C Committee to undertake projects around the College that are non-curriculum related

Family Capital Levy

The compulsory Capital Levy of \$890.00 per family ensures the College can continue to meet existing loan repayments while setting aside funds for future buildings or refurbishment of existing buildings.

School Fees

These fees enable the day-to-day running of the College covering such things as electricity, rates, telephone, building and grounds maintenance and staffing.

Technology Levy

This levy supports the use of technology integrated into the classroom environment. It provides for and maintains infrastructure and also covers student devices.

Student Levy

Items covered by the Student Levy include but are not limited to:

- consumable items used for subjects
- camps/retreats & excursions
- school yearbook
- pastoral care activities
- athletics days and swimming carnivals
- Student Accident Insurance

Optional Extra-Curricular Activities

We encourage and support student participation in co-curricular activities including interschool and representative sport, music, etc.

However, it is school policy that participation in these activities may be limited unless a mutually agreed payment plan is in place, or Fee Accounts are up to date prior to enrolment in these activities.

Enrolment Termination

A Term's notice of withdrawal of a student must be provided in writing to the Principal and is required to be provided by all parents that signed the Enrolment Agreement. Verbal notification or notification to a staff member other than the Principal, is not considered due notice.

Failure to provide the required notice referred to above, in respect of withdrawals from the College, will result in parents remaining liable to pay the following term's full tuition fees, unless otherwise negotiated with the Principal or Business Manager.

Enrolment Application Fee

A non-refundable fee of \$50 is payable upon submission of an Application for Enrolment.

Issuing of Accounts

Fee Statements are emailed out in Term 1 and will be due for payment within 14 days unless a payment arrangement has been organised with the College.

Payment Options

Payment of Fees & Levies can be made either ANNUALLY, QUARTERLY, MONTHLY, FORTNIGHTLY or WEEKLY.

Concessions

Xavier is committed to providing a Catholic education to all children whose parents desire it.

We are also aware that families may experience financial hardship from time to time and offer Concessions as per the Brisbane Catholic Education guidelines.

Concession applications are reviewed using a compassionate and just approach under the mission and values of the College and Brisbane

Catholic Education. The application process uses the Henderson Poverty Line when assessing eligibility for concessions. This process takes into consideration all income as well as housing costs.

Concessions are only issued for the school year they are applied in, and a new application must be submitted each year.
